

## PATTERN RIPPLES AND RIDGES COWL




Thank you for buying my pattern! I hope you will enjoy it!

### Sizes and measurements of finished garment:

Approx.. width - 34cm; circumference – 80cm

### Materials:

-  150g or 246yards of heavy worsted weight yarn

*For sample I used Scheepjeswol Stone Washed XL - Smokey Quartz (842) yarn, and though it is labeled as Chunky yarn I would rather consider it as heavy worsted weight yarn, but you can use chunky yarn as well, then only adjust the width or make it oversized.*

- two needles US size 7 – 4.5mm (you can use circular needles as well), or size needed to obtain gauge
- tapestry needle or crochet hook

### Gauge:

8 sts and 9 rows = 2in/5cm over St st using US size 7 (4.5mm) needles, or size needed to obtain gauge

### Stitches and abbreviations:

st(s) – stitch(es)

St st - stockinette stitch

k – knit

p – purl

yo – yarn over

ssk – slip one st knitwise, slip next st knitwise, insert left hand needle through fronts of slipped sts and knit the two sts together

k2tog – knit 2sts together



Cast on 52sts (or multiple of 13)

Rnds 1,2,3: knit (52sts)

Rnd 4: purl (52sts)

Rnd 5: \*k4, (yo, k1) 5 times, yo, k4\*, repeat from \* to end



Rnd 6: purl

Rnd 7: \*(k2tog) 3 times, k7, (ssk) 3 times\*, repeat from \* to end



Rnd 8: knit (52sts)

**Repeat Rnds 1-8** until the piece is 80cm long, or until desired length. Bind off. Put both ends together and make a seam. You can join both ends using crochet hook and work sl st in each st working through both layers. Or thread the tapestry needle with same yarn and make a seam using, for example, back stitch seam.

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
