



Notes

- Ch1 at beginning of row doesn't count as first st
- This pattern will be great for scarves, blankets, hats and clothing. You can use more than one color as well. Happy crocheting!

Stitches and abbreviations:

st(s) – stitch(es)
ch – chain stitch
sc – single crochet
dc – double crochet
sp – space

Special stitches

V- stitch (v-st)

Work (dc, ch1, dc) into the specified stitch



Bobble

Yarn over, insert hook in specified st and pull the yarn through(photo 1), *yarn over and pull the yarn trough the same st*, repeat from * once more.

Now you have 7 loops on your hook (photo 2), yarn over and pull it through all loops you have on the hook. Stitch completed (photo 3).



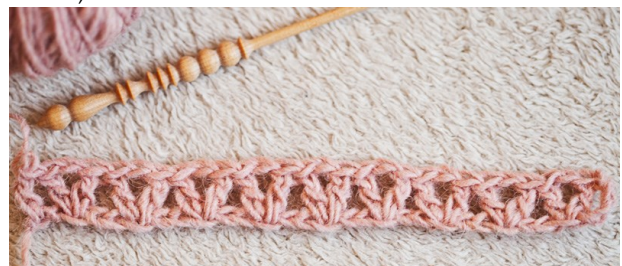

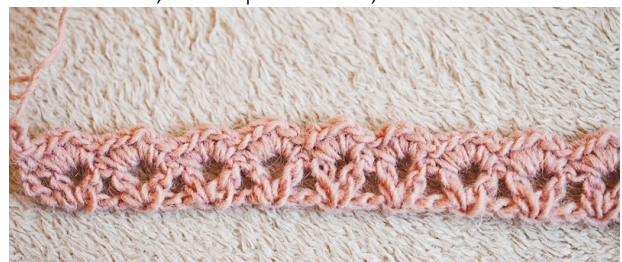

Pattern

Row 1: ch a multiple of 3+4, v-st in 5th ch from hook (ch3 counts as first dc here and throughout), *skip next 2ch, v-st in next st*, repeat from * to last 2ch, skip next ch, dc in last ch, turn



Row 2: ch1, sc in base of ch1, *5sc into next v-st*, repeat from * to end, sc in top ch of ch-3, turn



Row 3: ch3, skip next 2sc, v-st in next st, *skip next 4sts, v-st in next st*, repeat from * to last 3sts, skip next 2sts,



Row 4: ch3, skip next dc, *dc in next dc, ch1, bobble in skipped dc (working it over previous dc, see next photo), skip next dc*, repeat from * to last st, dc in top ch of ch-3, turn



Row 5: ch3, *v-st in next ch-1 sp*, repeat from * to end, dc in top ch of ch-3, turn



Repeat Rows 2 through 5 for pattern.

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
