



Notes

- Ch1 at beginning of row doesn't count as first st
- This pattern looks great and different on right and wrong sides, so you can play around with it. It will be great for scarves, blankets, hats and clothing. You can use more than one color as well. Happy crocheting!

Stitches and abbreviations:

st(s) – stitch(es)
ch – chain stitch
sc – single crochet
dc – double crochet
sp – space

Special stitches

Cluster (CL): *yarn over, insert hook in specified st and draw up a loop, yarn over and draw through 2 loops*, now you have two loops on hook (*photo1*), repeat from * two times more working in same stitch, (*photo 2*) yarn over and draw through all four loops, CL made (*photo 3*)

Shell

Work (dc, ch1, dc, ch1, dc) in specified stitch; shell completed.

Pattern

Row 1: ch a multiple of 4+5, dc in 5th ch from hook (ch4 counts as first dc and ch1, here and throughout), *skip next 3ch, shell in next st*, repeat from * to last 4ch, skip next 3ch, (dc, ch1, dc) in last ch, turn



Row 2: ch1, (sc, ch3, CL) in first dc, skip next 2dc, *(sc, ch3, CL) in next dc*, skip next 2dc*, repeat from * to last st, sc in last st (in 3rd ch of ch4), turn



Row 3: ch4, dc in base of ch4, *skip ch-3 sp, shell in next sc*, repeat from * to last ch-3 sp, skip ch3-sp, (dc, ch1, dc) in last sc, turn

Repeat Rows 2 and 3 for pattern.

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
